- 4. The nomination needs to be done in writing and give the reason why they are being considered.
- 5. The nomination must be given to one of the committee member.

A committee has been form to review and make adjustments to the current TGS By-laws. Specifically, this committee will determine whether the current Quarterly Journal, Terrebonne Life Lines, which is published four times a year, will change to a bi-annual journal to reduce shipping and publication costs. The current cost is \$30.85 per member and will be reduce to \$21.00 per member for a bi-annual journal. The board will finalize the decision and all changes made to the by-laws.
